

SEVIER, William Vol Capt., AQM

The National Archives files for Officers contain eight documents for William Vol Sevier; the files for Tennessee contain thirteen documents.

Sevier enlisted on August 1st, 1861, as a Private in Company E, 1st Regiment Tennessee Cavalry, at Cumberland Ford, Kentucky. On May 24th, 1862, Sevier was appointed as the AQM to that unit at Evans Ford. A muster roll dated July and August 1862 indicated that Sevier was stationed at Powel's Valley, (Tennessee?).

William Vol Sevier was appointed on July 2nd, 1862, as Capt. & AQM reporting to the 2nd Regiment Tennessee Cavalry (Ashby's), taking rank retroactively on May 27th, 1862.

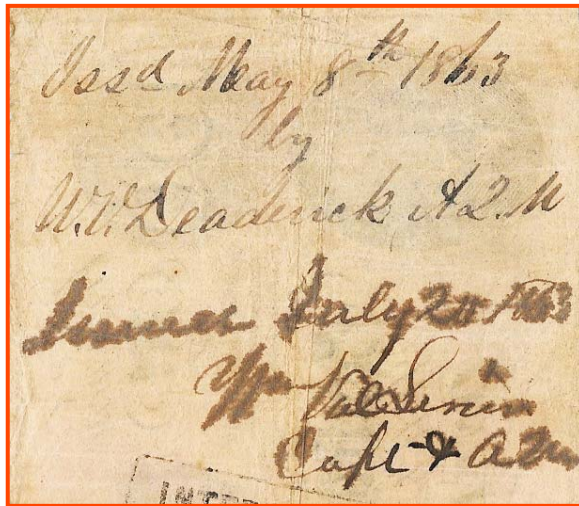
On February 21st, 1863, at Knoxville, Tennessee, Sevier signed a receipt for \$4,000.00 for funds received from Maj. L. E. Stainbock, QM. Sevier appeared on a list dated March 1st, 1863, at Jackson, Mississippi, of Quartermasters in the Army of Tennessee reporting to Alfred M. Barbour, Maj. & Chief QM, and Ashby's Cavalry, Davidson's Brigade, Wharton's Division, and Wheeler's Corps.

Sevier appeared on a list dated March 4th, 1864, at Tunnel Hill, Georgia, of Quartermasters on duty with the Army of Tennessee, Davidson's Brigade, Wharton's Division, and Wheeler's Corps. The ubiquitous list dated July 20th, 1864, at Atlanta, Georgia, noted in pencil that Sevier was "28 (years), Stout."

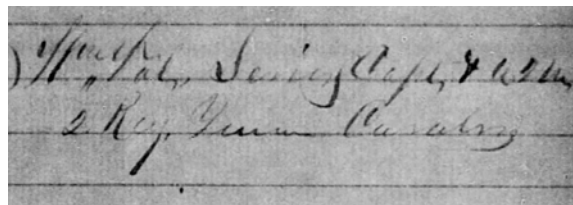
Sevier appeared on a list dated January 22nd, 1865, at Tupelo, Mississippi, of Quartermasters on duty with the Army of Tennessee, Ashby's Brigade, Hume's Division, and Wheeler's Cavalry Corps. He

was paroled in accordance with terms between Gen'l Joseph E. Johnston and Maj. Gen'l W. T. Sherman at Charlottesville, North Carolina, on May 3rd, 1865. The parole noted Sevier's residence at Rogersville, Tennessee.

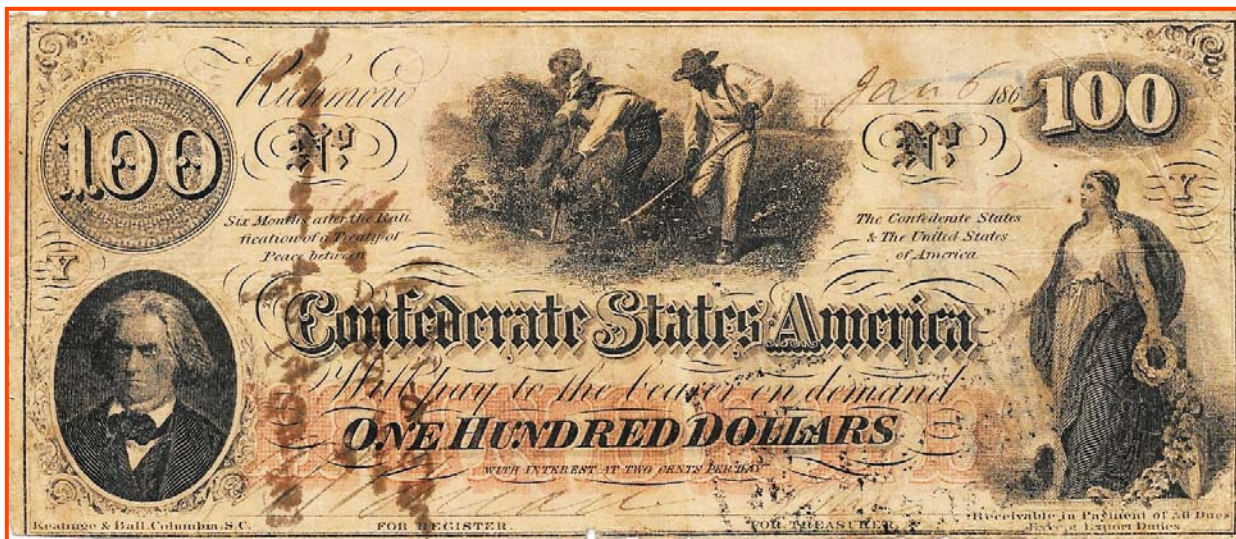


W. V. Sevier's signatures from the National Archives.
